

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Why can't I log in even if I have already created a GO-MIS account? An error message says my account has been deactivated.

A: You have not verified your account. Go to the email address you used in creating the GO-MIS account and look for a verification message sent by FPE. If it is not found in your Inbox, you may check on your Spam folder.

Q: Can I create an account and then finish what I started at a later time?

A: Yes. There is a Save function in the ORF and Proposal Application pages.

Q: Why does my account show this warning sign: Itemized budget total is greater than approved budget?

A: Please disregard this message. This appears because the system only recognizes the grant requested from FPE.

Q: How long does it take for FPE to review my proposal?

A: That will depend on the amount of grant being proposed. Small and medium grants usually take a month or less to be processed. Large grants need to be presented to the Project Development Committee, thus this will take up to three months to process.

Q: Will we be notified if our application is approved or rejected?

A: All applicants will receive an e-mail notification once their proposal has been approved or rejected.

Q: When the electronic application is submitted, should a hard copy be sent as well?

A: No, please don't send a hard copy, unless advised by FPE.

Q: Can I attached my full project proposal, photos or maps?

A: Yes, applicants are required to attach their full project proposal.

Q: Who can apply?

A: Those eligible are: a Filipino entity; a non-government organization, people's organization, and/or academic institution; and duly registered with any of the following: Securities and Exchange Commission, Cooperative Development Authority, Department of Labor and Employment – Bureau of Rural Workers, or from any other government certification bodies; and continuously in operation for a minimum of three years immediately preceding the application for grant support.

Q: What kind of activities will be supported?

A: Any activity that falls under FPE's grant focus (<http://fpe.ph/grants-focus.html>) and strategies (<http://fpe.ph/grants-strategies.html>).

Q: What size of grants are awarded?

A: Small grants are up to Php200,000 and with maximum of one (1) year implementation, medium grants are up to Php800,000 and may be implemented for two (2) years, while large grants are up to Php2,000,000 and may be implemented for two (2) years.

Q: Can a government institution apply for an FPE grant support?

A: FPE does not support government institutions, but they can partner with a local non-government organization, people's organization, or academic organization as co

Q: What are the grounds for disqualification from applying for FPE grant support?

A: Those with ongoing project with FPE, those that have pending accountabilities, and those with questionable track record

Q: Is there an application deadline?

A: There is no set application deadline, but allow enough time for FPE to process your proposal before the proposed implementation date. Large grants are presented to the Project Development Committee meeting held four to five times a year.

Q: If our application is declined, may we reapply?

A: Not if the proposal is the same and
